A Message from the President

Serving as President of the Board of Directors has been both challenging and rewarding. During the previous year GHK had experienced a very successful year in terms of grant funding. This year was much less successful therefore requiring some re-engineering of our fundraising activities. Although our Executive Director Paul Bandy continued to pursue a variety of grants, we experienced a dramatic decline in the approval of these requests. As a result we have formed a Development Committee for the express purpose of increasing community awareness and finding new and innovative ways to raise funds.

I am pleased to report we did experience a number of successes. GHK received a significant grant from the AQMD through the City of Glendale which will allow us to fund Project CHASE. Jo Ann Parnell, RN, our extraordinary case manager, initiated and managed two very successful dental clinics. The Center for Nonprofit Management was engaged to perform an organizational assessment of GHK. The report will be ready for presentation to the board in the fall of 2005. We increased our visibility within the Armenian Community with presentations to the Armenian American Chamber of Commerce and the Armenian American Medical Association. All of these activities will pay dividends in the years to come for GHK.

Just thanking the Board of Directors and past presidents for their support is hardly enough. Your continued commitment to GHK was exemplified by your willingness to actively participate in the formation of several new committees and project groups. I am particularly pleased with our medical and dental professionals who have formed an Advisory Committee to assist Jo Ann and to help attract and maintain our extraordinary group of volunteer dentists, medical doctors, pharmacies and other professionals who give so generously to the children of Glendale.

I am very excited about serving as Past President under the direction of Debbie Hinckley, our new Board President, and I look forward to the challenge of chairing the Development Committee during her tenure. I know that with the continued support of the City of Glendale, the Glendale Unified District, Glendale Memorial Hospital and Health Center, Glendale Adventist Medical Center and Verdugo Hills Hospital, along with the hundreds of volunteers and supporters, GHK will continue to serve the children of Glendale.

A Message from the Executive Director



The past year was Glendale Healthy Kids' eleventh year, and it was a busy year filled with significant achievements and challenges. I am happy to report that because of the continuing support from the community we are alive and well, and offering healthy futures for low-income children who are without access to health care.

As you read this annual report, you will see numbers that represent individual children who were helped by our volunteer physicians and dentists. Most of them have been significantly impacted by the help they have received, and have been given the opportunity to grow and learn free of pain from medical or dental problems. Also, the dental education volunteer teachers have made a life-long difference in the lives of first graders who were taught about oral hygiene and how to keep their teeth healthy and disease free. That kind of positive, life-changing outcome is difficult to quantify, but we know the children will have a better chance to stay healthy because of the hours of volunteer service donated through Glendale Healthy Kids.

We continue to work with our collaborative partners to improve our referral procedures and programs to more effectively meet the needs of the children we serve. Each of those partners maintains a high commitment to Glendale Healthy Kids, and we would not exist without their support.

With a grant from the City of Glendale, we are launching a new education program to enlist participation of organizations serving children in a more comprehensive effort to promote children's health. Project CHASE (Children's Health: A Shared Effort) will provide training in childhood diseases to the leaders and staff of community and faith-based organizations to equip them to better understand, accommodate and serve children facing a variety of health challenges.

Thank you for your continued support of our efforts to meet the needs of the children we are here to serve. Together, we will continue to work to provide healthy futures to the most vulnerable in our community, our children.

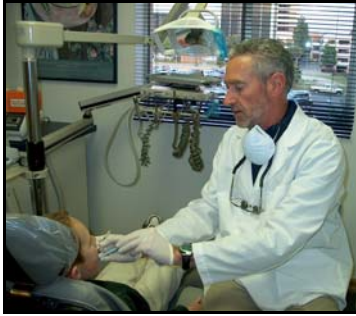

Glendale Healthy Kids Programs



Medical and Dental Referrals

Throughout the year school nurses refer students with acute medical and dental conditions to our case manager. An appointment is then made for the student with one of our volunteer providers, who gives treatment free of charge. The treatment provided ranges from simple examinations to surgery when needed.

Dental Education Program

Volunteers teach dental education to 1st grade students from a prepared curriculum. The course is a 3-part series which teaches proper oral hygiene and its importance. A dental professional also visits each classroom to discuss going to the dentist. Over thirty volunteers taught the program this year to nearly 2,000 Glendale Unified School District first grade students.



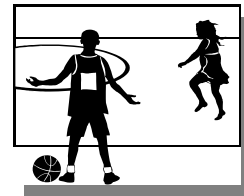
USC School of Dentistry's Mobile Dental Clinic



Approximately 100 students received comprehensive dental care through the clinic in July. In most cases, all work that is needed to restore a child's mouth to a healthy condition is completed during the week-long clinic. Those children requiring further dental work are referred to GHK dental providers. This was Glendale Healthy Kids' tenth year to sponsor the clinic.

Sports Physical Examination Program

This program is designed to provide a quality physical examination for student athletes in the Glendale Unified School district prior to their sports season. Participating Glendale Healthy Kids physicians provide examinations for a minimal fee on a regularly scheduled timeline.



Sight for Students



In collaboration with the Glendale Family YMCA, Glendale Healthy Kids participates in the Sight for Students program. Sight for Students, a project of Vision Service Plan, provides eye care services at no charge to eligible Glendale Healthy Kids students.

It Was a Very Good Year

GHK Success Story

On October 20, 2003 a 14 year-old boy injured his thumb at school. With no insurance, no transportation, and limited English, he entered the **Glendale Healthy Kids** system to be treated at the **Urgent Care Center**. He was placed in a thumb splint, returned to school, and after a few weeks resumed his normal routine. Several months later, during a basketball game, his knee gave out and he fell. When the school nurse contacted **GHK**, she reported that he had been in the office several times in the past for minor injuries related to running during P.E. **Urgent Care Center** saw him again and referred him to an orthopedist. An appointment was scheduled for the following week when he was examined and referred for pain medication and an MRI. Upon receiving the results of the MRI, the orthopedist recommended physical therapy. After an evaluation was completed and treatment started, the physical therapist contacted **GHK**. Not only was this boy in need of physical therapy to strengthen his leg muscles, he also needed orthotics to help correct severely flat feet which caused alignment problems. In view of the history of multiple injuries he had sustained when running, it was decided to find a way to provide him with the orthotics he needed. The persistence of the physical therapist, his concern for this young man, and the willingness of **Glendale Adventist Medical Center** to provide the needed services is a testament to the compassion of the professional community in caring for the children of Glendale. This young man recently received his orthotics and has had his final evaluation with the orthopedist.

In addition to the injuries received at school during P.E. classes, this same young man developed dental problems. He was first seen by one of **Glendale Healthy Kids** volunteer dentists in December of 2003. Over the course of several months, he received treatment on 11 teeth and lessons in good oral hygiene. Unfortunately, he again developed pain and swelling in his jaw. He was returned to the dentist and placed on antibiotics. Over the next few months 2 more fillings and a root canal were completed and a crown was placed. Thanks to the **Glendale Healthy Kids** volunteer providers he is now pain free, with healthy teeth, stronger legs and a more normal foot alignment. He has returned to school able to concentrate on his studies and to continue pursuing the activities of a normal teenager.

New "Mini Clinics" Make Children Smile

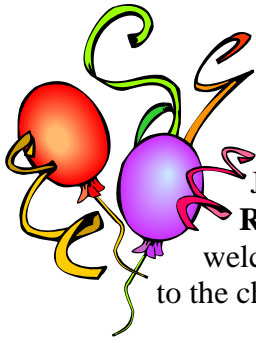

Children in pain from cavities or afraid to smile without hiding behind their hands are all too common in our community. But this year, thanks to a new program initiated by professionals who care, 54 children no longer suffer with pain or cover their mouths when they smile, and all 54 received an important lesson in how to take proper care of their teeth. This year a dental office in Montrose brought a new idea to **Glendale Healthy Kids**—mini-dental clinics. In January 2005, the office of **Dr. Stephen Giovanisci** called **Glendale Healthy Kids** looking for a way to give back to the community by participating in the American Dental Association's "**Give Kids a Smile Day.**" He initially signed up for a one-day clinic, opening his office on February 4th to treat only **Glendale Healthy Kids** children. He and his two associates agreed to provide cleanings, x-rays and exams. On February 4th, these three dentists and their office staff saw 31 children from 16 different families, loved what they were doing, and decided to become full-time **Glendale Healthy Kids** providers. They also made the decision to continue treatment on the 26

children who needed further dental care—treatment which included fillings, extractions, sealants, crowns and pulpotomies.

A month later **Dr. Jack Bayramyan**, a dentist who had been with **Glendale Healthy Kids** for over a year, called and asked how he could help screen children for dental needs and provide oral hygiene education. Another mini clinic was arranged and a date for April 19 was set. Once again the office was closed to all but **Glendale Healthy Kids** children. **Dr. Bayramyan** and his associate performed exams, x-rays and cleanings on 23 children. Treatment was completed on 11 of the children. The other 12 were referred to specialists for root canals and extractions or, if further treatment could wait, were referred to the **USC Mobile Dental Clinic** scheduled for July 8 through 15. One of the notes written by a 7 year old expresses the feelings of all the children: "Dear Dr...I liked the tooth brush. It was funny and tickly. I thought you were going to take my tooth out of my mouth. You are a cool and great dentist, and you are in the circle of sharing and caring and respect." We at **Glendale Healthy Kids** think all of the professionals who so generously donate their time and services to the children of Glendale are cool and great!

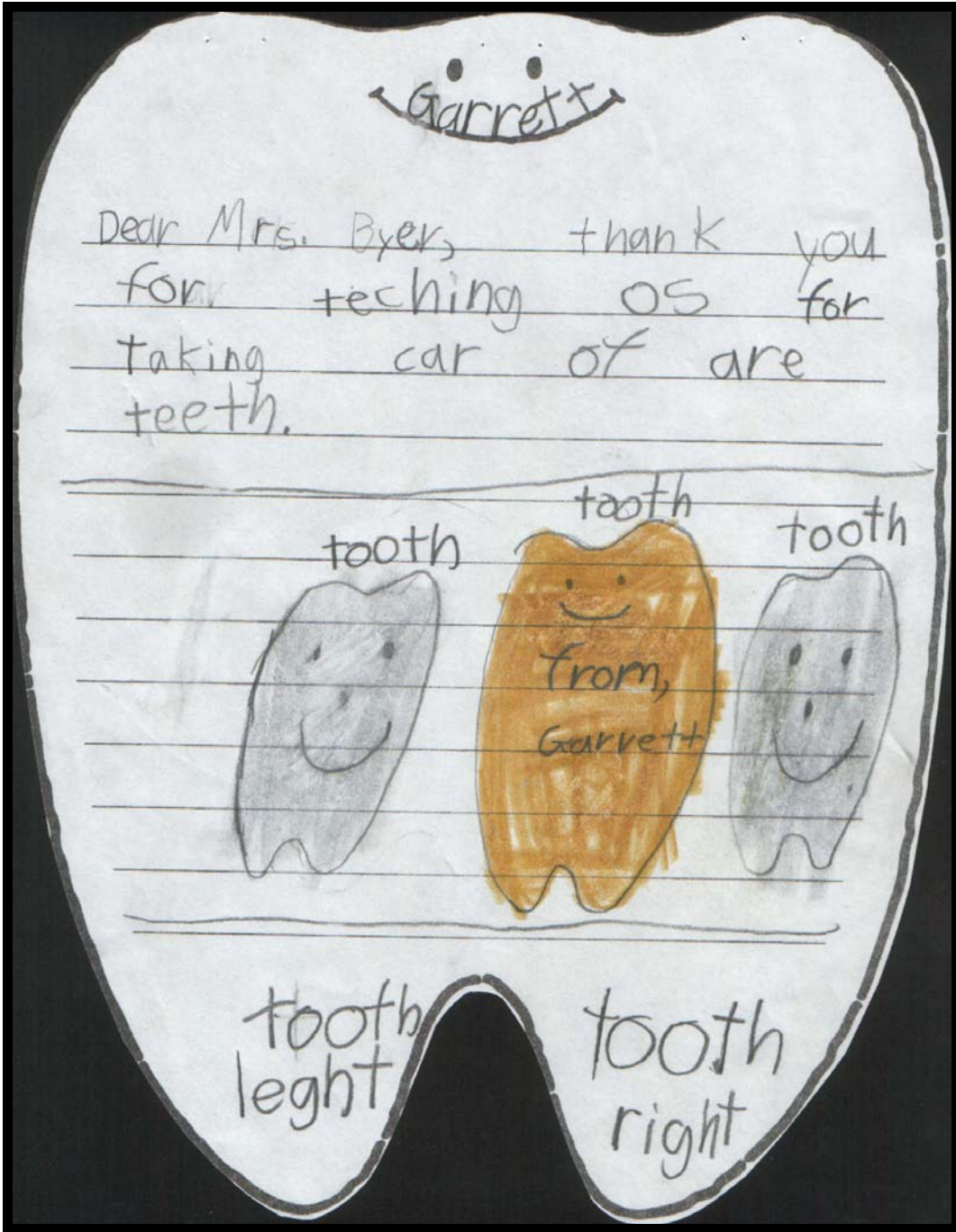
